### Abstract

General Education -Implementation of the Central Plan Scheme for Infrastructure Development in Minority Institutes (IDMI)-Release of first instalment of Grant-in-aid Capital assets for the year 2011-12-Administrative Sanction accorded-Orders issued.

### ORDER

As per the letter read as first paper above, the Ministry of Human Resource Development has informed that the Central Grant-in-aid Committee for the Central Plan Scheme for Infrastructure Development in Minority Institutes (IDMI) has selected 33 schools in the State of Kerala for Grant-in-aid Capital assets under the Scheme for the year 2011-12. Accordingly Government of India have approved an amount of ₹ 14,38,35,000/- (Rupees Fourteen crore thirty eight lakh and thirty five thousand only) and an amount of ₹ 7,19,17,000/- (Rupees Seven crore, nineteen lakh and seventeen thousand only) have been proposed to be released as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment (50%) under the scheme during 2011-12 as detailed below:-

2) An amount of ₹ 7,19,17,000/- (Rupees Seven crore, nineteen lakh and seventeen thousand only) has been released by Government of India as first instalment subject to the condition that the balance of 50% of the approved proposals will be released within one year of the release of first instalment during which period the 25% share of the minority institutions should have been contributed to the infrastructure upgradation.

3) As per the letters read as second paper above, the Director of Public Instruction has requested to accord Administrative Sanction to utilise the amount of ₹ 7,19,17,000/- (Rupees Seven crore, nineteen lakh and seventeen thousand only) for the infrastructure development in the 33 schools of the State as approved by the Central Grant in-aid Committee under the Scheme for IDMI in the year 2011-12.

4) Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction to utilise the amount of ₹ 7,19,17,000/- (Rupees Seven crore, Nineteen lakh and seventeen thousand only) released by Government of India for the year 2011-12 as first instalment of Grant-in-aid Capital assets for the Central Plan Scheme IDMI against the approval cost of ₹ 14,38,35,000/- Lakhs (Rupees Fourteen crore thirty eight lakh and thirty five thousand only) for the infrastructure development in the 33 minority institutes of the State selected by the Central Grant-in-aid Committee subject to the norms fixed by Government of India/Government of Kerala and the following conditions.

i) The Director of Public Instruction will ensure utilisation of released funds expeditiously in accordance with the norms of the scheme and as per approved proposals within one year after the receipt of the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment.

ii) The proposal for release of II<sup>nd</sup> instalment after utilisation of 75% of the available funds should be submitted within a period of one year after the receipt of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment.

iii) The Director of Public Instruction will submit a quarterly progress report along with audited expenditure certificate.

The expenditure involved will be debited to the Head of Account " 2202-80-800-51-35-Plan"


